

Add White Space / Line Breaks

Occasionally you may want to put more space between your form fields. You can use empty text sections to add white space to your form.

Step by step

To add white space to your form:

1. In the Form Builder, click **Add Content** at the top left corner of the screen.
2. Select **Text & Image** → **Text**
3. After your text is added, move the text box to where you would like the white space to be.
4. You can also drag and drop fields using the **Outline** view (in the **View** menu).
5. Select the text area and delete the text 'Edit this text'.
6. Press the spacebar key a couple of times.
7. Click **Done** and then **Save your changes**.
