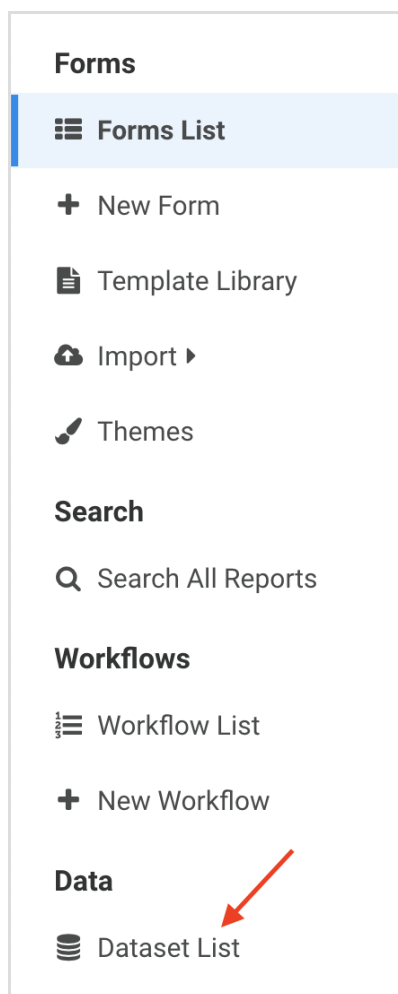

Managing Datasets

The **Dataset List** makes it easy to manage datasets you've imported to use with [our Autosuggest feature](#). Datasets are useful when you want users to be able to choose from lists of options too long for a dropdown menu. To access this tab, select **Dataset List** from the sidebar of the Forms List page.

Note: Datasets have a size limit of 5MB.



Requirements

To use Datasets, a FormAssembly user must:

- be part of an Essentials plan or higher
- have the **Can Use Datasets** user permission enabled for their login
- use Form Builder version 4.4.0 or newer

Active Datasets

Datasets that you've imported and are currently using will be shown in the **Active Datasets** section. This view contains information about the source of the dataset, the name, the language, the date it was created, the date it was last modified, and its visibility.

Click on a **dataset's filename** to access additional information about a dataset.

Click **Make Public** to make a dataset available to all users on your instance. By default, datasets will be set as Private, which means they can only be accessed by the user who imported them.

Click **Deactivate** to deactivate a given data set. This will remove the dataset from the existing datasets list you can access from within the Form Builder. Deactivating a dataset can be helpful, if you don't plan to use it frequently or when using many datasets to manage the length of the existing datasets list. Deactivating a dataset does **not** delete it, instead, it will move to the **Inactive Datasets** section.

Inactive Datasets

Datasets you're not currently using are shown in the **Inactive Datasets** section. Like the **Active**

Datasets section, this list contains information about the language of a dataset, the date it was created, the date it was last modified, and its visibility.

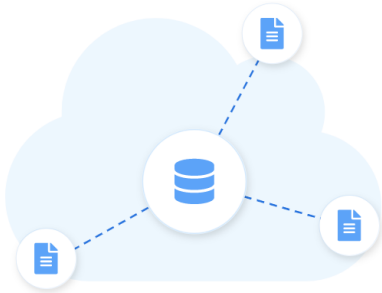
Inactive Datasets					
Your inactive Datasets. They are not selectable when configuring an Autosuggest field, but still work in forms they are already configured in. They may be reactivated for use, or deleted permanently.

Click **Reactivate** to reactivate a data set. This will make the dataset accessible from your existing datasets list in the Form Builder.

Click **Delete** to permanently delete a dataset from your account. **You should only delete a dataset if you're sure you won't need to use it again.**
