Overview

There may be times where you want to use FormAssembly's API to integrate with third party applications outside of FormAssembly.

In order to set up an API integration, you will need to register the third party application for yourself or for your users who wish to use the app.

Registering a Third Party Application for a User

In order to register a new third party app, navigate to your admin **dashboard** → **settings** → **third party apps**.

From there, click **Register a new application** at the top.

Next, enter the application title, and save the Client ID and Client Secret that are provided.

You can also add in an optional redirect URL if you would like to. This will be used as a security filter to restrict where a client callback will take the user. More details are available in our [GitHub documentation](#).

Register a New Application

APPLICATION TITLE

This is the application name which will be shown to the application users when they are prompted to authorize the application. It should clearly identify the application and its owning company.

OAuth Client ID

You will need to share this information with the Application developer.

OAuth Client Secret

You will need to share this information with the Application developer.

OAuth Client Redirect URI

 (Optional)

This is a security filter to restrict where a client callback will take the user. It is optional, for more details please see the [documentation](#).

Apply

Finally, click **apply**. Provide the Client ID and Client Secret to the application developer.

Note: Any user who will be using the third party application will need to have permission enabled to use the API. This can be setup under **Settings** → **User Roles**.
